⁴⁾ Where several documents are issued together to the citizen, a total fee of DKK 285 (BGN 75) shall be charged.

⁵⁾ Provided the request for VAT refund comprises several separate purchases, a fee of DKK 230 (BGN 60) shall be charged per statement.

⁶⁾ Where several provisional passports or extension of passports are issued at the same time, a fee of DKK 2,675 (BGN 700) shall be charged for the first passport, and DKK 1.145 (BGN 300) or DKK 1.786 (BGN 468) for subsequent passports.

⁷⁾ Where several provisional passports or extensions of passports are issued at the same time, a fee of DKK 3.820 (BGN 1000) shall be charged for the first passport, and DKK 1.145 (BGN 300) or DKK 1.786 (BGN 468) for subsequent passports.

⁸⁾ The fee may increase to DKK 135 (BGN 35) or DKK 180 (BGN 47) if an implementation decision has been adopted in the EU in accordance with the Visa Code Article 25a. does not apply to children up to and including eleven years of age.
